- Please respect others.
- Internet searches will not be monitored, but access to the Internet may be prohibited if searches are made for materials that are not within the library's selection policy.
- Illegal activity will be reported to the police.
- Please do not turn off any computers.
- The library is not responsible for materials accessed through the Internet.
- Parents are responsible for their children's access and use of the library's computers.
- Please do not attempt to violate computer system security.
- Please ask the library staff for help if you experience any difficulties with computers or printer.
- In fairness to all patrons, if you have been using a computer for over one hour you may be asked to end your session in order to allow others to have access to computers.
- All computers automatically shut down 10 minutes before the library closes. A warning message will appear on the screen alerting you that the computer will be shutting down.
- All personal information, passwords, etc. are deleted when the computers shut down at the close of the day. Your information will not be saved.
- Users must abide by copyright laws.
- There is a charge of 10 cents per page for black and white printouts, 25 cents per page for small color images, \$1.00 for full-page color images.
