What is an edible book? An edible book is food that can look like a book, be a pun on a book title, refer to a book character, or have anything to do with books, as long as it's edible.

4. Your entry form must be submitted to one of the libraries by March 25th.

Who's invited? The Edible Book Festival is a family event, free and open to the public.

What time? Entrants may set up at 1:15 PM. Viewing, tasting, and raffle begins at 1:30 PM.
